FOOD PANTRY IS JANUARY MISSION FOCUS - The January 27th last Sunday offering for missions will support the local Food Pantry. We encourage you to make a special effort to bring canned goods for the entire month of January. Canned fish, meat, and poultry; hearty canned soups and pasta entrees; canned or dried soup ingredients such as Chile beans; and hearty boxed meals, such as scalloped potatoes are especially welcome during the colder winter months. Monetary donations are also very welcome.

FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY - Traditionally, Trinity has been asked to provide two volunteers for Tuesdays in January. You will be paired with another church that will also provide volunteers. **No heavy lifting is required.**

Your service will take place at the Lighthouse Chapel (the former Town and Country Presbyterian Church) where the Food Pantry is located, from approximately 3:45 P.M. – 6:00 P.M. Signup sheet is available on narthex table.
