FOOD PANTRY IS JANUARY MISSION FOCUS - The January 27th last Sunday offering for missions will support the local Food Pantry. We encourage you to make a special effort to bring canned goods for the entire month of January. Canned fish, meat, and poultry; hearty canned soups and pasta entrees; canned or dried soup ingredients such as Chile beans; and hearty boxed meals, such as scalloped potatoes are especially welcome during the colder winter months. Monetary donations are also very welcome.

FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY - Traditionally, Trinity has been asked to provide two volunteers for **Wednesdays** in January. You will be paired with another church that will also provide volunteers. **No heavy lifting is required.**

Your service will take place at the Lighthouse Chapel (the former Town and Country Presbyterian Church) where the Food Pantry is located, from approximately 3:45 P.M. – 6:00 P.M. Signup sheet is available in the narthex on the Missions' bulletin board.

THRIFT SHOP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED - The Family Thrift Shop relies on volunteers from area churches. The Thrift Shop has requested that Trinity provide two volunteers for four hours each, one day each month. That is only four hours per month for each of the two volunteers. This year Trinity's volunteers are asked to work from 1-5 PM., usually the second Wednesday of the month. ** Most of the time you can be seated, taking payment for and/or bagging purchases. You will not be required to do anything strenuous, and you will have someone working with you.
