FOOD PANTRY VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY - Traditionally, Trinity has been asked to provide two volunteers for *Wednesdays* in January. You will be paired with another church that will also provide volunteers. **No heavy lifting is required.**
