HUMAN RELATIONS DAY ON JANUARY 19TH - Human Relations Day calls upon United Methodists to minister to those whom Jesus called “the least of these”, those living on the margins of society struggling to survive. Jesus embraced and served people like this, and the UM Churches established Human Relations Day as a Special Offering Sunday that calls all of our UM Churches to participate and helping all God’s children to realize their potential.

Trinity's New Visual Aid Equipment

The new equipment consists of a media cart that mounts a 55" flat screen TV, and a new DVD/CD disc player.

AED (Automatic External Defibrillator)

The AED is used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. It's a sophisticated, yet easy-to-use, medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock, or defibrillation, to help the heart re-establish an effective rhythm.

This extraordinary device has been purchased by Dr. Janice Alexander and the Memorial Ministry and is wall-mounted in the narthex. The AED can be used on adults and children, and has an activated voice that will assist with each required step needed during use.


